**THE ONLY RULER YOU CAN TRUST**  
Psalm 146:3, Isaiah 11:1-10, Psalm 2

1. Put NO trust in rulers. Psalm 146:3
2. The One Ruler you can trust – Jesus. Isaiah 11:1-10
3. Rulers – and all of us – must trust in Him. Psalm 2

<sup>6</sup>*For to us a Child is born, to us a Son is given;  
and the government shall be upon His shoulder,  
and His name shall be called*

*Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God,  
Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.*

<sup>7</sup>*Of the increase of His government and of peace there will be no end,  
On the throne of David and over his kingdom,  
to establish it and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness  
from this time forth and forevermore.*

*The zeal of the Lord of hosts will do this. Isaiah 9*

<sup>1</sup>*Behold My servant, whom I uphold,  
My chosen, in whom My soul delights;  
I have put my Spirit upon Him;  
He will bring forth justice to the nations. ...*

<sup>5</sup>*Thus says God, THE LORD,  
who created the heavens and stretched them out,  
who spread out the earth and what comes from it,  
who gives breath to the people on it ...*

<sup>6</sup>*“I am THE LORD; I have called You in righteousness;  
I will take You by the hand and keep You;  
will give You as a covenant for the people, a light for the nations,  
to open the eyes that are blind,  
to bring out the prisoners from the dungeon,  
from the prison those who sit in darkness. Isaiah 42*
