MORNING SERMON OUTLINE

WHOM YOU MUST KNOW John 17:3

Note the bulletin insert with information about the great Reformation of the church in the 16th Century. Note the reference at the bottom to the "solas" – sola fide (faith alone), sola Christe (Christ alone), sola gratia (grace alone), AND sola Scriptura (Scripture alone).

These were rallying cries of the Reformation – and should still be precious and foundational for us & for our church. We will look in particular in the next two weeks at sola Scriptura.

But this morning we need to see, of *first* importance, the vital connection between the Scriptures and Jesus Christ – vital for your salvation and growth in faith & vital for the health and testimony of the church.

1. You must know Jesus Christ & God the Father - John 17:3

John 17: We are privileged to listen in to the prayer of the eternal Son to

His eternal Father – as the Son reviews His mission on earth
in anticipation of His approaching "hour" of suffering & glory.

The Father gave His Son authority over all humanity

& He gave Him people (see Jn.6:37-39) -

that He may give them eternal life. That is why He came.

What this implies about OUR condition and need (dead in sin & unbelief).

What Jesus did to give life to dead sinners: died on the cross & rose again. What is necessary for us to do?

"This is eternal life, that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent" (vs.3).

What does this mean? More than factual knowledge about Jesus, but living, relationship knowledge – trust, surrender, communion...

You must receive & believe the Bible as the very Word of God to know Jesus, the living Word.

Problem: How can WE know what is true about Jesus,

so that we can can truly know the true Jesus?

There are many man-made false Christs and "plastic Jesuses."

This is why it is so important to understand WHAT the Bible is:

God's Word of truth revealing Him who IS Truth.

Listen to the testimony of the Apostles - eyewitnesses to Jesus:

John 1:14, 2:11, ... 20:30,31. 1 John 1:1-4.

Hear the promise of Jesus to send the Spirit of *truth*: John 14:26, 15:26f, Hence, the assertion of Peter, 2 Peter 1:16.

The character of Scripture: 2 Timothy 3:16 & 15;

& the Apostle Paul's admonition: Colossians 3:16 -

"Let the Word of Christ dwell in you richly ..."

= the Word that reveals Christ to us, because it is the Word that comes from Christ to us by the Spirit.

Guided by the Holy Spirit, the Apostles & Prophets have borne faithful & true witness to Christ, by which you may know Him & have eternal life.
