***TWO LOST SONS & THE FATHER'S LOVE***  
**Luke 15:11-32**

The 3<sup>rd</sup> of the parables of Luke 15 is commonly known as the Parable of the Prodigal Son, but that title gets only half of our Lord's point about the amazing saving grace of God. He is calling "prodigals" to come to Him in repenting faith to experience the Father's saving love. He is also calling the proud & self-righteous to see their sin and their need also for the Father's forgiving grace. Jesus "seeks and saves" lost sinners – lawless rebels and Pharisees, who come to Him in humble repentance.
